We are currently looking for a QA/QC Coating Inspector with a NACE level I or level II Certification. Inspectors will be employed at the Hanford Tank Waste Treatment and Immobilization Plant in Richland, WA.

JOB SUMMARY:

The QA/QC Coating Inspector will perform all inspections, examinations and tests required by F.D. Thomas procedures and WTP specifications under the direction of the QA/QC Manager.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

Quality Assurance/ Quality Control:

- Perform inspection, examination and testing according to FDT and WTP procedures and specifications.
- Equipment calibration and maintenance
- Read and understand all WTP coatings specifications, procedures, change notices and field change requests.
- Documentation of all inspections, examinations and tests performed by the painting crew.
- Complete appropriate daily QC reports per piece of work performed and turned in daily.

Production Planning and Scheduling:

- Coordinate a work schedule with multiple crews, foreman and co-workers to facilitate production.
- Assure appropriate timing for inspection of all mandatory hold points for the work being performed.

- Meet all compliance regulations as dictated by BNI WTP safety personnel

- Work with other company safety professionals to meet site needs
